Who are NCRQ?

National Compliance and Risk Qualifications - NCRQ - are the biggest provider of health and safety diplomas in the UK. Our qualifications are developed by some of the biggest employers in the UK, alongside experts from the regulator and leading professionals. We offer a self-directed method of study - this means you can learn in your own time, from anywhere you choose. There's no need to attend a classroom or sit any exams, so there will be no unnecessary time away from work.

How is it assessed?

Assessments are designed to reflect real workplaces, and test the skills that are actually required by employers. We use scenarios and tasks, and students will have between two and six weeks to complete an assignment in their own time. You request these assignments whenever you feel ready. At the end of each unit, you will undertake a short online validation interview. Don't forget each unit of the diploma is a level 6 certificate - so you will actually end up with three qualifications!

Will there be anyone to contact if I need help?

Of course! Our tutors are available to discuss any element of the course via email and phone 7 days a week. All tutors are former regulators with extensive experience in every sector - so they can give you real-world answers to your queries.

How long will it take to complete?

Most students take somewhere between 6 and 12 months to complete the qualification with regular study. You will have three years in total to complete it.

Is it accredited?

Our diploma is accredited by AIM Awards in partnership with NCRQ. This ensures that the qualification is regulated by Ofqual and is recognised throughout the UK and EU. It is also accredited by IOSH for Graduate Membership.

Who is it aimed at?

You can undertake this diploma if you have no health and safety knowledge at all, but it is designed to complement at least some health and safety duties. On completion of the diploma, you will be able to confidently manage employees undertaking higher risk activities, have the skills to advise an employer as a 'competent person', register as a h&s consultant, be able to undertake a safety management role and have a comprehensive understanding of a wide range of risks in the workplace.

How much does it cost?

The diploma costs just £2100+VAT for UK and EU students - one of the most cost-effective solutions compared to other routes. We do offer payment plans over 12 or 24 months for individuals, or you can split the diploma into three separate units thereby spreading the cost.

Many of our students have their employer fund the qualification because of the clear advantages and potential for cost savings.

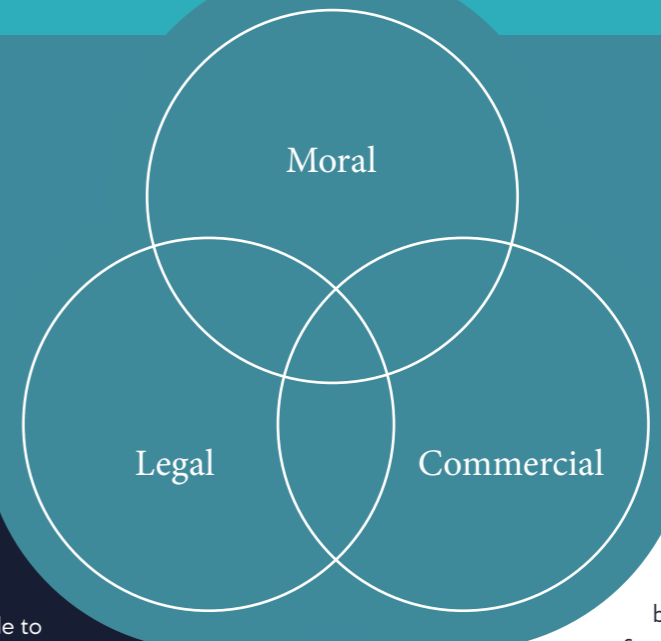
